Post-Tour Day: Begin Your Post-Tour Extension: Lisbon

After an included breakfast, enjoy another day to experience the timeless allure of Lisbon. From your central location on Avenida da Liberdade, you are perfectly positioned to explore both the historic heart of the city and its modern, vibrant neighborhoods.

You might begin in the Alfama district, where steep lanes and tiled façades lead to breathtaking viewpoints such as Miradouro de Santa Luzia. Pause at a café for a *bica*—Lisbon’s signature espresso—before visiting the Lisbon Cathedral or the National Pantheon, resting place of many of Portugal’s most beloved figures.

Later, you could hop aboard the vintage Tram 28, which winds through many of Lisbon’s most scenic quarters, or cross the river to the Almada district for striking views back toward the city. Art lovers may wish to visit the Museu Calouste Gulbenkian or the MAAT (Museum of Art, Architecture and Technology), both known for excellent exhibitions.

Lunch and dinner are on your own today. Lisbon’s culinary scene invites exploration—from contemporary tasting menus in Chiado to simple taverns serving grilled sardines and regional wines.

Post-Tour Day: Continue Your Post-Tour Extension

After a leisurely breakfast, continue discovering Lisbon at your own pace. You might head to the Belém district, where Portugal's Age of Discovery began. Visit the Jerónimos Monastery and Belém Tower, both UNESCO World Heritage sites, then treat yourself to a visit to the historic original home of Pastéis de Belém, where warm custard tarts dusted with cinnamon have been served for generations.

Alternatively, consider a day trip beyond the city. The fairytale palaces of Sintra, the seaside charm of Cascais, and the dramatic cliffs of Cabo da Roca—the westernmost point of continental Europe—are all easily reached by train or private excursion.

Back in Lisbon, you may wish to browse the boutiques of Chiado, explore the lively streets of Bairro Alto, or walk along the riverfront promenade.

As evening falls, consider joining locals in Bairro Alto for an aperitivo, or dine at a cozy restaurant where the soulful strains of fado echo through candlelit rooms—an unforgettable farewell to your Portuguese adventure.
