DAY 1: Travel to Johannesburg

Wake up early to make the most of this last precious day of your South Africa hiking tour starting with a light breakfast in the lounge, preparing you for one final morning game drive. Take midmorning refreshment in the bush as you track the abundant wildlife. Return to the lodge for a leisurely brunch with time to freshen up before you pack up and decamp. You bid your hosts a warm farewell before boarding your included flight back to Johannesburg.

Upon your arrival into Johannesburg, transportation will be provided to the lovely African Rocks Hotel for your overnight. A peaceful oasis just 15 minutes from the airport, this small, personal hotel invites relaxation. Depending on your time of arrival, unwind in the poolside gardens or the hotel's small library. (No other activities or meals included.)

DAY 2: Travel to Victoria Falls. Begin your Post-Tour Extension

An early morning flight delivers you to the Victoria Falls Airport (VFA), Zimbabwe, where you are met by a representative from your hotel and transported to your home for the next two nights, the charming Stanley & Livingstone Boutique Hotel (an approximate 20-minute drive).

Upon arrival, settle into your spacious suite overlooking the lodge's private game reserve, spanning nearly 10,000 acres. Then enjoy lunch in the hotel's 1871 Restaurant or alfresco by the swimming pool. Afterward, relax by the pool or on your private deck, take a short nature walk around the property, or perhaps indulge in a spa treatment (additional cost).

This evening you may decide to embark on an exclusive rhino safari. The Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve has been designated a rhino Intensive Protection Zone and is home to the elusive black rhino. After enjoying an afternoon tea at the hotel, you meet with an expert guide for an immersive talk about the conservation and management of this important species, followed by a game drive in search of the rhino. Afterward, return to the lodge for a scrumptious three-course dinner.

Please Note: All meals, beverages, and activities are not included in your tour price unless noted otherwise. Should you wish to add on any optional Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve activities or Victorian Falls excursions such as the "Flight of the Angels" helicopter ride over the falls, these can be booked through your lodge. To avoid disappointment, pre-booking is encouraged, but many activities can also be booked upon arrival.

DAY 3: Guided excursion in Victoria Falls National Park

No description, no matter how vivid, can prepare you for the reality of Victoria Falls. Natives call it "the smoke that thunders." Geologists call it "the greatest-known curtain of falling water," and the "Seventh Wonder of the Natural World." The majestic Zambezi River sends water plummeting over the edge of the falls' massive gorge, with a width of one-and-a-quarter miles plunging over 330 feet deep.

The falls transform the placid Zambezi River into a ferocious torrent exploding into clouds of spray seen from miles away. Trace footpaths along the gorge-side cliff through the mopane woodland and rainforest. The vegetation you observe, including ebony, ivory and date palm, is rare for this region, nurtured by spray from the falls. Throughout your walk, pause at inspiring viewpoints and keep your eyes open for one of the 35 species of fish-eating raptors. Fish eagles, peregrine falcons, and others perch in riverside trees waiting to dive for their catch.

After your tour, you have the option to stay back in the town of Victoria Falls to enjoy lunch in one of its numerous restaurants or partake in one Zimbabwe's famous thrill-seeking activities such as the "Flight of the Angels" helicopter ride, white water rafting on the Zambezi River, or a tour of the historic Victoria Falls bridge. The lodge provides complimentary scheduled transportation to and from Victoria Falls throughout the day. Or, you may wish to return directly to your lodge for relaxation and join one of the activities offered on the reserve.

DAY 4: Departure

After an included breakfast, and depending on the time of your flight today, you may have time for one last activity, perhaps a final game drive, horseback safari, or a guided tour to the local community of Woodlands and Masuwe Primary School. Complimentary transportation is provided to Victoria Falls Airport (VFA), Zimbabwe, based on your departure time. Your flights may arrive at your final destination in North America the following day.
