DAY 1: Fly to Lisbon, Portugal

Begin your adventure by departing from a convenient gateway city in the United States or Canada. Spend your first night aloft.

DAY 2: Arrive in Lisbon, Portugal. Begin your Tour Extension

Upon arrival at Lisbon's Portela Airport (also known as Huberto Delgado Airport), a representative holding a Country Walkers sign will meet you as you exit the baggage claim area. A complimentary small-group transfer will be provided to your Lisbon hotel, approximately 30-40 minutes away. The remainder of the day is at your leisure (no meals included).

If you are going to be delayed meeting our transfer representative for more than 15 minutes due to delayed or lost luggage, please contact our local partners at the following (Spanish) mobile number +34 647 751 105 to advise of your delay, and they will contact our transfer service on your behalf. Our drivers are generally able to wait for up to 45 minutes from the time your flight lands, after which you would be responsible for your own transfer.

Please note: If you arrive early, and your hotel room is not available prior to the designated check-in time, you may store your luggage with the reception desk.

DAY 3: Full day in Lisbon

Portugal's vibrant capital, with its grand plazas and hilly terrain, offers both beautiful vistas and cultural treats. Castelo de São Jorge, once the site of a former Moorish residence, is a historical wonder, as is the Torre de Belém—a fortress on the Tejo (Tagus River), also a UNESCO World Heritage site. The quirky National Coach Museum displays ornate horse carriages along with the stories of their royal occupants. The Gulbenkian Museum's collection of Old Masters and Impressionist art is a rewarding stop, as is the beautiful St. Jerome Monastery, built to celebrate Vasco da Gama's discovery of a sea route to India in 1498. (Lunch and dinner are on your own.)

DAY 4: Full day in Lisbon

After breakfast, continue your exploration of Lisbon. Perhaps you'll visit the popular Lisbon Oceanarium, where you can view the wonders of the undersea world, or ride the iconic Tram 28, people-watching as you rattle past historical buildings. As your hotel is on the city's main avenue, described as "Portugal's Champs Élysées" you can plan out your days' activities knowing that sights, restaurants, and shops are always close at hand.
